Because You Say So, J will

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven. (Matthew 5:16) **J will shine the light of Jesus**

All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one. (Matthew 5:37) **J will speak the truth**But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, (Matthew 5:44) **J will love others even when J am hurting**

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:33) **7 will seek God's will in all 7 do**

Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. (Matthew 6:34) **7 will trust God**

Stop judging by mere appearances, but instead judge correctly." (John 7:24) **7** will look beyond the exterior and into the hearts of others

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. (John 13:34) **7 will love as Jesus loves**

Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the works themselves.

(John 14:11) J will believe in Jesus and trust what J have seen of Him

"If you love me, keep my commands. (John 14:15) **J will show J** love God by doing what He says

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. (John 15:5) *J will stay connected to Jesus and draw on his strength to do all things*
